I bring **good news**, we have an opportunity to get **positive change in Broadwaters!** A By-Election has been called for **Thursday the 6th of February 2025**. For too long Broadwaters and the Wyre Forest has heard too many words and not seen enough action.

The **Conservative Worcestershire County Council** has just announced a **£33.6 Million funding shortfall**, which has not been at all helped by the **Labour Government's announces no additional central government funding**. At the same time the **Conservative County Council** is putting in their bid to merge with local district councils to create a 'unitary' council, **absorbing their reserve funds and income producing assets**. We need to see assets devolved to town councils to make sure money stays in the local area and doesn't get used to cover the **financial mismanagement** of the last **decade of the Conservative run County Council**.

With the **potential of local elections being delayed to 2026** to form a larger Centralised Unitary Council, on the horizon, it's more important than ever, that we have **local people from Kidderminster, making decisions for the people of Kidderminster!**

Why? Because up and down the country, **Liberal Democrat Town Councils are making their local areas better**. From: Community Land trusts, **building affordable housing for local residents, to tackling speeding**, improving the local environment and providing more youth outreach services.
